## Using JAM with an iPad

1 Plug JAM into your iPad using the provided iPad dock cable



2 Plug your guitar into JAM's 1/4" input




Check the status light on JAM, it should be Blue



- Blue JAM is connected but not ready
  Green JAM is connected, ready and working with your software
- Red Your gain is too high, adjust the gain using the Gain Control Knob on the side of JAM
- 4 Start up GarageBand and choose New Song (JAM's status light should turn to green)



Choose Guitar Amp





and following instructions

- Plug your headphones into iPad's headphone output or just listen through iPad's built-in speakers
- 8 Click the Record button and you are recording with JAM!

## Using JAM with a Mac






2 Plug your guitar into JAM's 1/4" input





3 Check the status light on JAM, it should be Blue


