The volume pedal enables you to use your foot to expressively control the volume of your guitar, bass, keyboard, or other musical instrument leaving your hands free to play the instrument. The rugged—yet lightweight—design includes selectable input impedance making this one of the most universally compatible volume pedals available today.

## - CONTROLS, I/O JACKS -

**INPUT Jack** – Plug a standard 1/4" instrument cable with TS plug into this jack. Connect the other end of the cable to your guitar, bass, another effects pedal, keyboard, or other instrument.

**OUTPUT Jack** – Plug a standard 1/4" instrument cable with TS plug into this jack. Connect the other end of the cable to your amp, other effects pedals, or another device such as a mixing console or recording interface.

**HI-Z/LO-Z Button** – This button allows you to select the impedance of the Volume pedal from LO-Z to HI-Z. The impedances presented for each setting are the following:

$$LO-Z = 25k\Omega$$
  
HI-Z = 250k $\Omega$ 

We recommend the HI-Z, or **in** setting, for most guitar and bass signals. The LO-Z, or **out** position, is best suited for keyboards and other electronic musical instruments as well as line level signals.

**Foot Pedal** – As you sweep the foot pedal from heel to toe the volume of the signal increases from minimum to maximum. The output signal is muted in the heel position.
