- 9 Do not defeat the safety purpose of the polarised or grounding-type plug. A polarised plug has two blades with one wider than the other. FRONT PANEL



Experiment with the Gain control to achieve the desired balance.

Set to the minimum position before switching the unit ON.

The footswitch switches between the two volume settings. This can be used as a boost for solos.

When using the Phones output, keep the Volume control low to avoid overloading headphones or the input of your mixer/recording console. Adjusts the tonal response. Turning clockwise reduces mids and produces brighter tones. Turning fully clockwise 'scoops' the mids entirely. Turning anticlockwise increases the mids and smooths the treble.



Adjusts the gain level. A variety of tones can be achieved, from clean (low setting) to heavy distortion (higher settings) and everywhere in between. With the Gain set to minimum, no sound will be heard.

REAR PANEL



Ensure this switch is set to OFF before connecting the included power adapter. Ensure the power adaptor is connected before switching on the **TERROR STAMP.**
