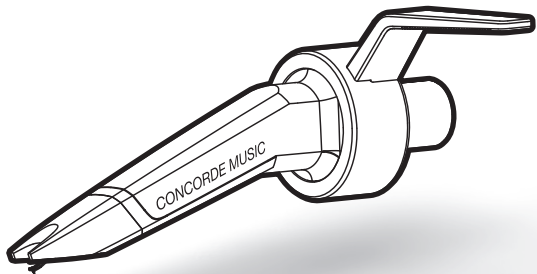

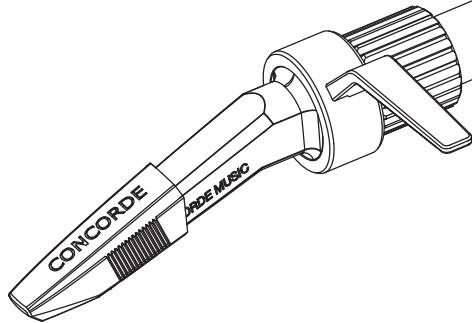

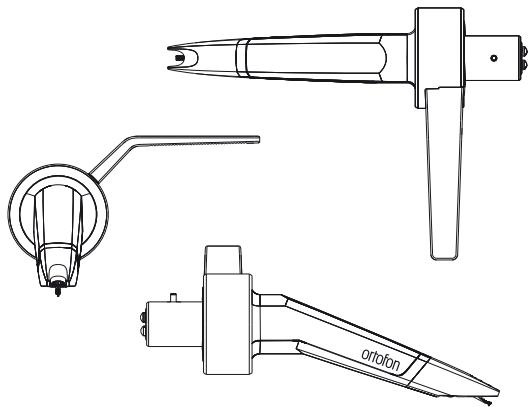

Mounting the *CONCORDE MUSIC* cartridge

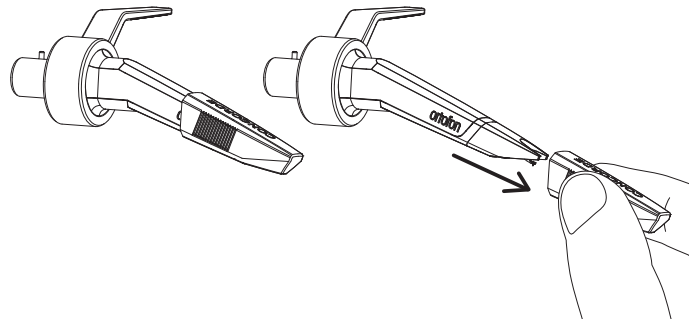
1. To protect the stylus, it is recommended to keep the stylus guard on the stylus when installing or removing the cartridge.
2. Mount and connect the cartridge by plugging the cartridge into the end of the tonearm, and gently tighten the finger screw.
3. Please set the tracking force to 1.8 g to ensure optimal tracking and sound quality.
4. Adjust the anti-skating according to the record player's manual.





Stylus guard

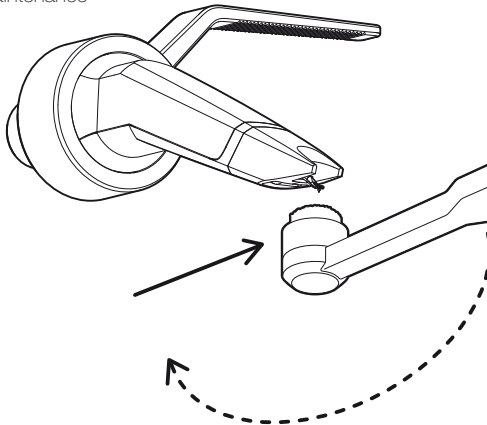
Remove the stylus guard before use by holding each side of the guard with your fingers and gently moving it in the opposite direction of the stylus.



Stylus care and maintenance

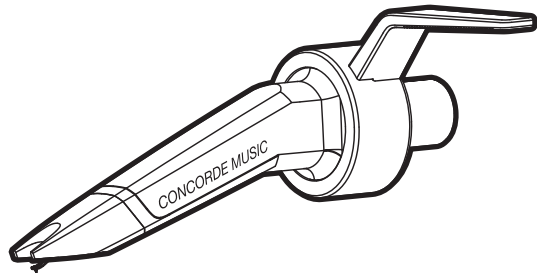
Remove dust from the stylus regularly by using a stylus brush to obtain optimal sound reproduction.

Do not use alcohol, solvents, or any other cleaning fluids to clean the product as this may damage it.
